Appendix 2: Prophetic Journey

'Cast the net out wide'. (2023)

We sense God asking us to step out in faith (unless God shows up then it's never going to work!) in something that enables us to 'cast the net out wide' to give as many people as possible the opportunity to respond to the gospel.

A vision (2023)

It was of the church building - (it looked like a WW2 emergency hospital) people were coming and going with various wounds and injuries. They were coming because they were in need of help but had nowhere else to go. They were coming in and finding help and healing and care. It was a constant flow of people.

I had a later picture of a Sunday gathering with people worshipping. It was an atmosphere of thankfulness. People were there out of worship for God because of a gratitude for what He had done for them.

Prophetic words (Worship night with Luke Finch, 20th Aug 23)

- Seeds from previous revivals bearing fruit in the present. Praying over the seeds of revival that are in the ground of Kilsyth.
- Returning to our first love and God returning to His first love (us and Kilsyth). People will be drawn to the love of God (we may ask for signs and wonders but predominantly it will be a move where many will be drawn to God's love), that our house is a place of "first love".
- When we started, I saw a picture of a square glow from a window set on a hillside. I was asking God what it was, got nothing and set it aside. As the worship progressed and Luke sang about returning to first love and God meeting us halfway and Kilsyth and the fires etc.

I sensed the words from John 14:23 "Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them."

I felt the picture is one of homecoming; the glow and the warmth of welcome as there is a return to our first love. God is returning with the fire and warmth and welcome of His presence. This is the beginning of Homecoming. Amen!

Word (2023)

The church wooden beams come from the ceiling up high curving downwards, the light starts at the top and floods downwards wider like a sweeping flood of light. The light signifies God's glory, God's filling, a downward sweeping of light and life, it pours down to those in the church, it spreads as it pours downwards filling, rippling the room, there is an outwards working of this light that spreads to others – God's glory will be known, Kilsyth will be filled. Something about downwards, sweeping, spreading, filling light.



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As we seek to accomplish **the vision that Christ gave His Church** and being open to the **prophetic voice of the Holy Spirit**, we see direction in what God is doing and where He is leading us together here as Church of God, Kilsyth (**an *ekklesia* – ‘called out ones’**) at this time.

The common thread is that we are a beacon on a hill and people will come to find help and healing – “You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden (Matthew 5:14)”. Rediscovering first love that draws people in...our vision and mission centres on being centred on Christ, a place of love and light that reaches out to the community.

Church Vision

We are **Christ-centred** believers, seeking to **serve each other** and our **community in love**.

Radiate

As we **centre** ourselves on **Jesus**, we will **radiate** the **love, light** and warmth of His presence to our **community** and beyond.

Radiate

Radiate - diverge or spread from or as if from a **central point.*

Radiate - to let out rays of light and heat, spreading out from a **central point.*

Matthew 5:13-16

¹³ “You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.

¹⁴ **“You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.** ¹⁵ Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, **and it gives light to everyone in the house.** ¹⁶ In the same way, **let your light shine before others**, that they may see your good deeds and **glorify your Father in heaven.**



Kingdom Growth – Can We See It? (January 2024)

Matthew 13:31-33 (The Parables of the Mustard Seed and the Yeast)

31 He told them another parable: “The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field. 32 Though it is the smallest of all seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds come and perch in its branches.”

33 He told them still another parable: “The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into about sixty pounds^[a] of flour until it worked all through the dough.”

So, the parables of the mustard seed and yeast work together to reveal the nature of the kingdom of heaven in Jesus’ ministry.

- The mustard seed emphasizes a small and inconspicuous beginning of the kingdom of heaven with its growth into external greatness.
- While the yeast suggests its hidden permeation and transformation.
- Despite its small, inauspicious beginnings and hidden nature, the kingdom of God will pervade the world and eventually produce the prophesied greatness.

I think we need to sometimes admit that with our human eyes we sometimes struggle to see with the eyes of faith where God is at work – especially in relation to the mustard seed and the yeast (the small and hidden).

And yet, we can be sure (as with God’s kingdom as a whole) there is growth – it may seem small or sometimes imperceptible, but we know it’s growing and will continue to grow.

Former Things and a New Thing (September 2024)

We sense that God has been speaking about us as a Church **‘By Faith’ stepping into something and to somewhere new. This idea of a New Thing.** That to keep moving forward as a church, **it is going to require us to conquer something new** - to move to a new place (Spiritually and by faith) in order for God to do a new thing. **Not just a continuation of the old, but the new.** And that **The key that unlocks the door is faith.** Amen!

Isaiah 43:18-19

¹⁸ “Forget the former things;
do not dwell on the past.

¹⁹ See, I am doing a new thing!
Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?
I am making a way in the wilderness
and streams in the wasteland.



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We sense that God is saying to us as church at this time - Can we 'by faith' step out knowing and believing that something has been conquered in Kilsyth in the past and something can and will be conquered again!

You see, as a church only by moving forward 'by faith' in God and His promises can we begin to grasp and perceive the new thing that God has for us. Amen.

Now speaking to us as a church today these verses can propel us forward to the new thing that God has for us. God would say to us together - **the past can be a springboard to launch ourselves into the future with God.**

There are especially **two key aspects** of our Church's DNA (in our History) that God is asking us in this season to pick up again with fresh faith, even if aspects of methodology may be different – i.e. we are not necessarily asking God to move in the same way as the past by we are asking God to move in the same Power as the past.

- 1. Our Pentecostal Roots**
- 2. Our Missional Roots**

So, what we see - Moving forward as a church is going to require us to conquer something new. And we do this by steeping into it 'by faith' and knowing that the past can be a springboard to launch ourselves into the future with God.

Prophetic word (2025): Often God allows us to hear the sound of the new season before the new season comes. And that is also why we need to be leaning into the prophetic voice of God in this season – allowing us to speak it out, pray it and live it.

Prophetic Words from Week of Prayer (September 2025)

Tuesday 9th

Felt that with this week being representative of the season that we're in – that we are in a chrysalis - a cocoon stage – where we have a protective cover, a wrap around us, in the Spirit – as we are protected for a period of growth and transformation, leading to new life and greater glory. Let us be hidden in the shadow of His wings as we move through this season. May we be wrapped and sealed in the Spirit, to protect and preserve growth to greater levels of glory.

Tuesday 9th

Shift in prayer – to partner with the prophetic and start of operate with a prophetic edge to all that we do, our prayers need to shift from request and petitions only – and become declarations and decrees.



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This is part of how the Lord will use us to usher in the new season – and become part of our shared language and common in how we pray – that we will perceive a thing, declare it to be so, to call it forth and see it come to pass.

The Lord has given us direction and vision – we are now to pray as those given trumpets and swords – to boldly proclaim what the Lord will do and to give a sharp edge to our prayers to cut through in the Spirit. We are to shift our language forward – pulling the potential of the future and the plan of Heaven into the present.

In this season – It's good and right to ask but it's better to declare.

It's good to request – but it's better to decree.

So to our prayer points:

- Thank you, Holy Spirit, that we are a people being continually filled – that we each have an endless supply of Your fire, wine and oil.
- We declare that we will be a people living in the reality.
- We give thanks for a renewed empowerment to be effective witnesses for Christ.
- We declare, as Your Church, that we desire to move deeper in the Spirit, marked by a hunger for more – and recognised as a house that is filled with and flowing in the Spirit.
- We call forth a season of new depth and increased measure in the things of the Spirit for our leaders – to move in greater depths of glory and from there, lead us all to that place together.

Wednesday evening

The Lord showed me the snow starting to fall. It eventually covered the whole of Kilsyth. It looked so pretty.

The snow was covering so many things that didn't look pretty!

The Lord said “Look at what is under the soil. I am asking you to ‘call forth’ your spiritual heritage!”

“My blood is the answer.

As you speak forth MY WORD in faith, changes will come!!”

The land will look good again!

I will do a new thing!”

Ephesians 6 – Put on the FULL ARMOUR!!

Stand FIRM in His Word!!!

Now is the time of letting God's light shine through us. People will respond as they see us individually and collectively reflect God's glory with integrity. Light reflects brighter off of a clear mirror. We need to be right before God, cleansed and pure in all we are and do.
